In Uganda the school year begins in the January-February time frame. Most of

During this time people were not allowed to travel anywhere and as a result of this, many lost their jobs. Some could not even work in the fields they rent to grow food. So many became hungry and the need was great. Relationships in the homes became strained, some even turned violent. The youth were affected the most,

Genesis Primary School




Though Ugandan schools were closed most of 2020 they opened Vocational schools and Universities as well as some secondary school grades late in the year. Genesis teachers offered small group and individual

tutoring as pandemic restrictions allowed. The 7th grade returned late in the year for further studies toward their final national exams which would determine what quality of secondary schools to which they would be accepted. The students completed the exams a little late, in early 2021, and 20 scored in the top level with 6 scoring high in the second level.

Please pray for a 2021 school year with fewer limitations and creative ways to help kids academically as well as nutritionally in spite of limits.
