The year of 2022 was a very exciting year. The COVID restrictions lifted, offering a time to start up the Awana Kids Club, a time to get back in school and start our lives again, and even more, a time to worship the Lord in church with other believers! We give thanks to you and to our Lord for His continued faithfulness through everything!

Children did indeed begin school again with a fresh spirit of really studying. They were concerned that there would be no chance of edu-

cation again. The Genesis Nursery/Primary School children did well. We were so excited to hear from the National Education Board that our school performed very well on the national exams for the 7th graders (the test taken to determine high school opportunities).

This is a big part of our vision to raise Christian leaders that will make a difference in their country and community, to the glory of God. Education is important and we work to get these children into the best schools possible at a reason-

able cost. Values, morals and quality academics help shape our children. We also desire for them to have a meaningful Christian influence, which we offer at our Genesis School and some of the boarding schools do as well. Scripture Union clubs are available at all of the non-faith-based schools, and we ask all of our students to become involved in these studies. The bible tells us to bring up a child in the way they should go, to give God glory and honor Him all the days of their lives.

The children's home was successfully renovated at the beginning of 2022. This makes us all feel safe now that the roof will not come crashing down on us!!! The ceilings were also replaced, as they are attached to the roof in the way that building is done here. We give thanks to the many donors who helped us with this project.

We brought seven new children into the children's home that range in age from 3 years up to 11 years. We give thanks for the chance to serve them and the Lord



through raising them up in Christ and with lots of love. Goma and Israel graduated university with flying colors. Goma is enjoying his work as a morning show co-host on one of the country's television stations while Israel is helping us out with his finance and business skills while he is seeking a permanent position in the big city. We praise God that they love the Lord and are becoming the Christian leaders that we desire to see come out of Hines Ugandan Ministries.

- ◆ Our 471 faithful donors, including 290 sponsors ,helped us care for approximately 559 children between Kamonkoli & Soroti with 6 graduates.
- ◆ Provided over 18,000 food baskets for community families and 10,000 for sponsored children and their families/guardians.
- ◆ Boosted our mercy fund for special needs like surgeries, hospitalizations and special medicines, \$5,579.
- ◆ Supported 367 students at our Genesis Primary School. Our 30 7th graders performed in top categories on their national exams.
- ◆ Provided many of our sponsored youth and higher education students with school books and supplies and boarding supplies.
- ◆ Supplied school shoes and uniforms for our sponsored kids in all schools as well as non-sponsored Genesis kids.
- ◆ Built a new home for a sponsorship family.
- ◆ Drilled a deep, clean water community well in a remote area of the community.

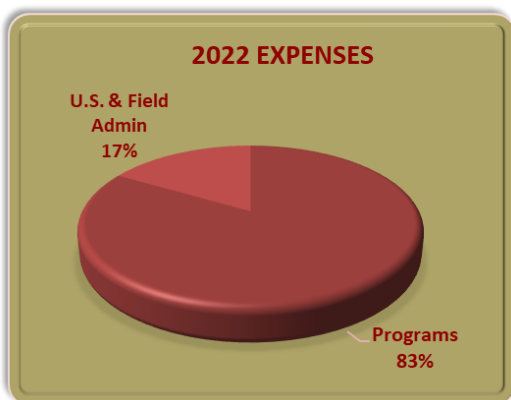
