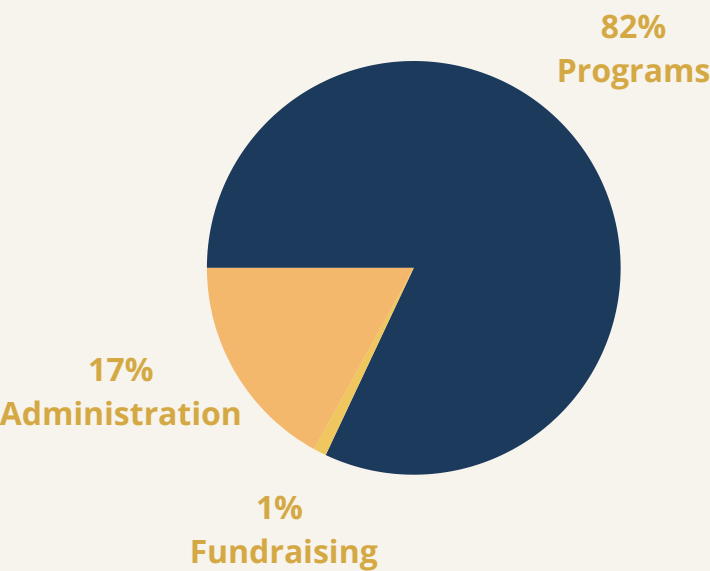


2025 Financial Overview

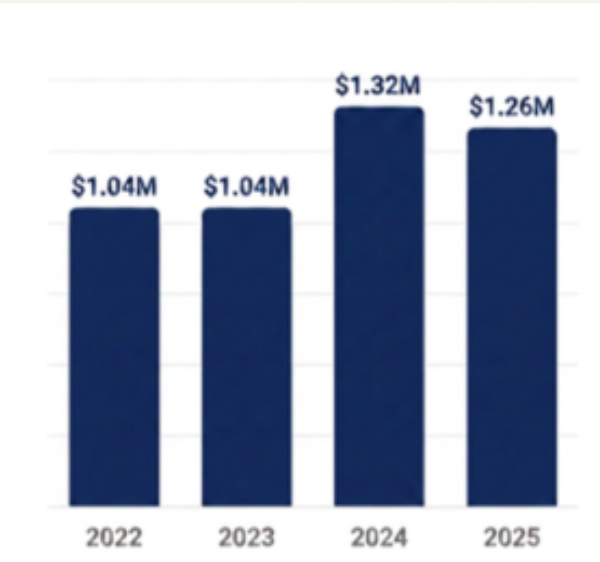
Total Revenue: \$1,259,663

- **\$160/month** sends **1** high school student to boarding school
- **\$150** provides termly school supplies for **5** children at Genesis
- **\$200** buys **10** pairs of school shoes for students
- **\$500** stocks our clinic pharmacy with medication for **1** month
- **\$700** feeds **1,200** children a healthy meal at our weekend feeding program

- Water collection barrels at Genesis School (\$500)
- Fire Extinguishers for School and Clinic (\$500)
- Play and learning materials for preschool classrooms (\$1,000)
- Computers for staff (\$2,000)
- Overhead projectors for Genesis classrooms (\$5,000)
- New Copy Machine (\$6,000)
- Extracurricular program development- sports, music, arts (\$30,000)
- Funding for Ministry Outreach Center construction (\$115,000)
